GROWER 30-0-0 is a liquid slow release nitrogen fertilizer. It derives from the combination of water soluble poly-methylene urea with small percentages of free urea and is a highly condensed source of liquid nitrogen.

CHARACTERISTICS

The condensed fertilizer GROWER 30-0-0 acts in the plant nutrition in the following ways:

- Offers gradual release of nitrogen.
- Provides an energy source for the beneficial soil microorganisms.
- The release of nitrogen acts in conjunction with the increase in soil temperature, microbial activity and the plant's increased needs for nitrogen.
- Is resistant to volatilization and leaching due to the nitrogen form that it contains.
- Does not contain suspended particles and does not need any special agitation.
- Is ideal for fertilization systems in which problems of clogging or abrasion appear.

It can be mixed with almost all fertilizers and chemical products. GROWER 30-0-0 must always be the first to add in the solution. Very acidic solutions must always be neutralized before mixing with GROWER 30-0-0. All the water soluble powders must be dissolved in water before mixing with GROWER 30-0-0.

APPLICATIONS-APPLICATION RATE

The following application rates are applied for the full coverage of the crops in relation to nitrogen. In case that GROWER 30-0-0 is applied subsidiary as to increase the nitrogen fertilization, apply one quarter of the recommended below application rates.

Foliar Applications

Generally apply 3-4 times throughout the growing season at the following application rates:

Vegetables: 10-25 l/ha.

Trees: 10-20 I/ha. Vineyard: 10-30 I/ha.

Cotton, Tobacco: 5-10 l/ha.
Potatoes, Sugar beets: 20 l/ha for a

single application or 5 l/ha for many

applications.

Soil Applications

Apply every 15-30 days throughout the growing season at the following application rates:

Vegetables, Strawberry: 25-45 l/ha. Vineyard: 25-45 l/ha.

Trees, bushes: 45 l/ha.

CAUTION
